The League of Women Voters of the District of Columbia invites all women and men to join us on **Thursday, August 26, 2010**, to commemorate the 90th anniversary of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution of the United States when women in the U.S. gained the right to vote.

This event in front of the White House and Lafayette Park will also seek to draw national attention to the lack of full voting representation and autonomy for citizens of DC.

It will take place all day and participants are welcome at any time.

Participants are encouraged, but not required, to wear white and are also welcome to choose to come as an original suffragist.
